said Burlington councillor Bob Wood.

"We should be making a strong statement to the Ministry of Health that this is a crucial issue for Halton," he added.

Committee chairman Ralph Scholtens said the region had no choice in the matter unless it was willing to absorb the capital costs to keep Martin House open and as well as construct a new facility in Burlington.

"It's a question of whose going to

pay the freight. There's not going to be anymore provincial funding," he noted.

Burlington councillor Robert MacIsaac suggested some saving might be realized by housing seniors in group-home settings instead of institutions.

"You see handicapped persons in group homes when you didn't a few years ago.

"I think there's room for some creative solutions," he added.

Patrons will be welcome to search the system for information on government programs, public or volunteer organizations, counselling agencies, community and sports groups.

Information Milton is located in the bottom level of

the Optimist Centre, 311 Commercial St. It's part of Milton Community and Information Services, an umbrella organization which provides office space to various social service agencies and houses the CHERISH Parent/Child Centre, a toy library, a housing registry service and private home day care program.

Most people who use the Information Milton Services do so by telephone. All calls are confidential. The organization does not use a call display system.
