Noted artists at Nassagaweya Art Show

An opportunity to view and purchase works by some of the area's best known artists is available this weekend at the Fifth Annual Nassagaweya Art Show and Sale, Friday and Saturday (Oct. 1-2).

The show takes place at the Nassagaweya Community Centre on Guelph Line in Brookville, six kilometres north of Highway 401.

The exhibit features works of 22 local artists, including Tina Newlove and Ursula Reese of Campbellville, Nicole Southworth of Moffat, Maureen Casteller, Vicki Ferras and Rosemary Simpson of Milton.

The show and sale is on from 4 p.m. through 9 p.m. Friday and from 11 a.m. through 6 p.m. Saturday. It includes a wide range of media, from traditional watercolors to sculpture and calligraphy in all price ranges.

Fine art is the major focus, but the Halton Board of Education is also providing a special exhibit of student art.
