Ward 2 town councillor John Challinor brought the issue up at Monday's council meeting, suggesting that local employment and tax assessment might suffer if the arrangement is scrapped.

He urged council to consider making a formal request that the deal be given serious non-partisan consideration by the Liberal government. Other municipalities and some provincial governments have already protested the loss of the contract. Mr. Challinor said.

He equated the EH 101 deal with the Avro Arrow, a Canadian high performance fighter which was developed and cancelled in the 1960s, and which current wisdom has suggested was a major blunder because of financial and research losses to Canadian high technology industries.


