## Harris says need not jobs key to chopper deal

A decision on the EH 101 helicopters should be made on the basis of need rather than how many jobs they will create, according to Ontario Progressive Conservative Party leader Mike Harris.

Mr. Harris, in town for a party fundraiser Tuesday, added that he was not fully conversant with the helicopter contract as it was a federal matter.

"In my view there is a minimum level for defence and the decision on the EH 101 should be made on how well they fill the requirements of defence rather than on the jobs they create," Mr. Harris said.

"Somebody has to make the decision. If it's determined that we need them, then we should try to get the best deal for jobs. (Prime Minister Jean) Chretien's mistake is committing to scrap the deal without first looking at it. I hope he does."

"It's what's wrong with Canada. Pork barrel politics and make-work projects are not the answer."

Mr. Harris said he was supportive of municipalities in their protest to the federal government. Officials of the Town of Milton are on the verge of launching a protest to the federal government because Derlan Aero-

space, a local employer, is at risk of losing contracts linked to the deal.

"(Lucien) Bouchard (leader of the federal Bloc Quebecois) started the ball rolling on the protests by claiming a billion dollars," Mr. Harris said. "I think he did it to make English Canada mad."

On the local front, Mr. Harris said that with the next election 12-18 months away, work was being done to attract a candidate.

"It's a constant building process," he said. "We hope to have nomination meetings for local candidates in the next 6-12 months in those ridings which we don't presently hold. We have approached people locally." He declined naming them.

## Challinor ties choppers to killing Avro Arrow

Ward 2 town councillor John Challinor brought the issue up at Monday's council meeting, suggesting that local employment and tax assessment might suffer if the arrangement is scrapped.

He urged council to consider making a formal request that the deal be given serious non-partisan consideration by the Liberal government. Other municipalities and some provincial governments have already protested the loss of the contract, Mr. Challinor said.

He equated the EH 101 deal with the Avro Arrow, a Canadian high performance fighter which was developed and cancelled in the 1960s, and which current wisdom has suggested was a major blunder because of financial and research losses to Canadian high technology industries.

Mr. Gee said that if the deal with Westland was withdrawn, Derlan would sue them to recoup money spent thus far. In turn Westland would sue the Canadian government for recovery of lost funds including those awarded, in turn, to Derlan.
