Halton reviewing lobby group membership

Halton Region will sit back and gather the facts, play a little politics and then decide.

Last week the regional administration and finance committee recommended that Halton gather information on a growing split in the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) and proceed with attempts at reconciliation before reviewing its membership.

The City of Ottawa wants to tear the system down and has asked Haiton, among other municipalities, to Join them in breaking away from AMO and forming a splinter organization to further the interests of large population centres in Ontario.

AMO has a task force to deal with

concerns and disenchantment from the large urban groups regarding "fair and equitable respresentation." Halton chairman Peter Pomeroy and Halton chief administrative officer John Burke both sit on the commit-

Mr. Pomeroy urged reconciliation, suggesting that part of the problem was simply the logistics of getting all the interested parties together to

discuss their problems. "A couple of people out there are unhappy with the role that AMO is playing," Mr. Pomeroy said. "I'm one of them.

However, "while AMO can afford to lose the membership of some small municipalities, it can't lose a bunch of Ottawas before the organization collapses," he added. "I firmly believe we should stick with AMO and restructure. It needs to be better and either we get that resolved or we're out. We don't want to waste time and money."

Mr. Leone, a member of the student pit crew, said he looks forward to spending time at the racetrack because "it lets me work with my hands and I enjoy watching the cars."


"I enjoy being at school because of the car," he added.
