

Solid showing for swimmers

The Milton Swim Club earned several team and individual first places at the Kinsmen Invitational Swim Meet hosted by the Dorado Swim Club Sunday in Brampton.

In the girls 11-12 age group the Milton relay team took firsts in both the 100 and 200 metre relays. In the 100 free relay the team consisted of Jessica Roselle, Kathleen Charco, Jennifer Dumencu and Kendra Miller. The 200 metre medley relay team was made up of Roselle, Dumencu, Miller and Kassi Slickers.

Miller earned a first in the 100 metre breast as well, while Roselle was first in the 100 metre freestyle. Dumencu was second in the 100 metre breast.

In the girls 9-10 group Alicia Majka's highlight of the day was her first in the 50 metre breast stroke.

In the girls 13 and older group Beth Meehan placed first in all the events she swam in — the 200 metre medley, 100 metre back, 50 metre fly and 100 metre freestyle.

In boys 9-10 action, the Milton team finished on top in the 200 metre freestyle relay. The team consists of Chris Dumencu, Kevin Cooper, Eric-Scott Nichols and Matthew Ishoy. Dumencu was also third in the 50 metre freestyle.

The team of Trevor Armstrong, Dumencu, Ishoy and Scoot Armstrong placed second in the 200 medley relay.

Chlisczyk gets two silvers in first qualifying gym meet

Fiona Silcock, in novice two competition, turned in a personal best with a fourth on the balance beam.

Pre-novice two competitor Jessica Deshaw, in her first-ever qualifying meet, handled the pressure exceptionally well and placed fourth in vault and fifth on the bars.
