
NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION HIGHWAY 401 FROM HIGHWAY 6 TO GUELPH LINE

THE STUDY

The Ontario Ministry of Transportation has completed a study which recommends widening a section of Highway 401 from 1.5 km east of Highway 6 South (Brock Road) to 0.7 km west of Guelph Line, a total distance of 10.1 km. Construction activities will include:

- Widening Highway 401 to six lanes throughout the project length by the addition of new passing lanes in the existing median;
- Re-construction and paving of the median and outside shoulders;
- Construction of a concrete median barrier;
- Installation of a closed drainage system (storm sewer)
 in the median;
- · Resurfacing the existing Highway 401 lanes; and
- · Rehabilitation of the C.P.R. Overpass.



THE PROCESS

This study followed an approved planning process. As required, an Environmental Study Report has been prepared and is available for review at:
