

Here's the rundown on area ski slope competition

On January 22 the Milton Heights Mackenzie Silver ski team travelled to London and came away with a convincing 121-74 win.

Milton's top three female finishers were Lindsay Tracey of Guelph who was first with a combined time of 49.02 seconds, Jana Neuman of Mississauga who was second in 49.62 seconds and Lindsay Ince of Oakville who was fourth in 50.96.

The top three finishing males were

Kyle Behse of Burlington placing first with a combined time of 42.97, Jeff Cole of Milton who was second in 44.97 and Willie Cripps of Rockwood, who was third with a combined time of 46.10.

The fastest single run of the day for a female went to Tracey in 24.39 and the fastest boy was Behse in 21.35.

The next week, the Mackenzie Silver team hosted a four way race at

Glen Eden, where they raced against the Oshawa Thunder Club. Milton beat the previously undefeated team 118-78. Milton swept all three top spots in both boys and girls races.

Milton Heights' top three females were: Neuman who was first in a combined time of 46 seconds flat, Ince with a combined time of 47.53 seconds and Tracey in 47.74.

Milton Heights' top three males were: Cripps who was first in 41.57 seconds, Cole who was second in 42.03 and Behse who was third in 42.65 seconds. Cripps had the fastest run of the day at 20.78 seconds while Neuman crossed fastest for the girls in 22.97 seconds.

The Hershey Alpine Red team travelled to Devil's Elbow Jan. 30, and beat Hidden Valley 108-88.

Milton's top three females were Tammie Wilson of Burlington who was first in a combined time of 58.33 seconds, Maria Fredriksson of Milton was second in 58.67 seconds, and Kim Davis of Oakville who was seventh with a combined time of 60.93 seconds.

Milton's top three males were Kevin Martin of Campbellville who was first with a combined time of 53.95 seconds, Ron Couper of Burlington who was third with a combined time of 53.95 seconds and Ian Yarrow of Mississauga who was fourth in 55.67 seconds.

The Hershey Alpine White team travelled to Oshawa Ski Club the same day and defeated Snow Valley 118-74.

Milton Heights' top three males were Matthew Foletti of Mississauga who was first in 53.42 seconds, Andrew Keller of Milton who was second in 54.08 seconds and Colin Martin of Campbellville who was third in 54.34.

The Hershey Alpine Blue team travelled to Batawa on January 30 and raced against Devil's Elbow losing 104-83.

Milton Heights' top three females were Cindy Davis of Oakville who was second, Leigh Hunsinger of Campbellville who was fifth and Bridget Mitchell of Mississauga who was seventh.
