

# Dubien is chosen Duquesne captain

Milton's Damien Dubien has been selected as one of two captains of the 1994 Duquesne University (Pittsburgh) baseball team.

Fellow teammates selected Dubien and Mike Beimel of St. Mary's, Pennsylvania as captains by a secret ballot as the team prepares for its 39 game season.

"Damien is our number one workhorse, without a doubt," Duquesne coach Mike Wilson said. "His experience will really help this season."

Dubien returns to the Dukes as the team's number one starting pitcher. The lefthanded fireballer posted a disappointing 1-10 record in 1993 but notched 56 strikeouts in 58.1 innings.

In addition he picked up valuable experience pitching for the Canadian National team at the World University Games in Buffalo. Dubien shut out Cuba, the eventual gold medalists, during a one inning stint and beat the United States by pitching five and a third innings of scoreless relief.

"Since this is my first year coaching at Duquesne, I didn't feel it was my place to choose captains," Wilson said. "I must say that I couldn't have asked for two better guys."

Co-captain Beimel returns to the

team after a one year hiatus. Two years ago as a freshman, Beimel started in 27 of the team's 31 games, posting a solid .292 average with four stolen bases and was tied for second on the team in RBI with 18.

The Dukes' season begins on March 2.

In other first-round action, Hamilton will take on Royal York, Burlington battles Georgetown and Brampton goes head-to-head with Streetsville.

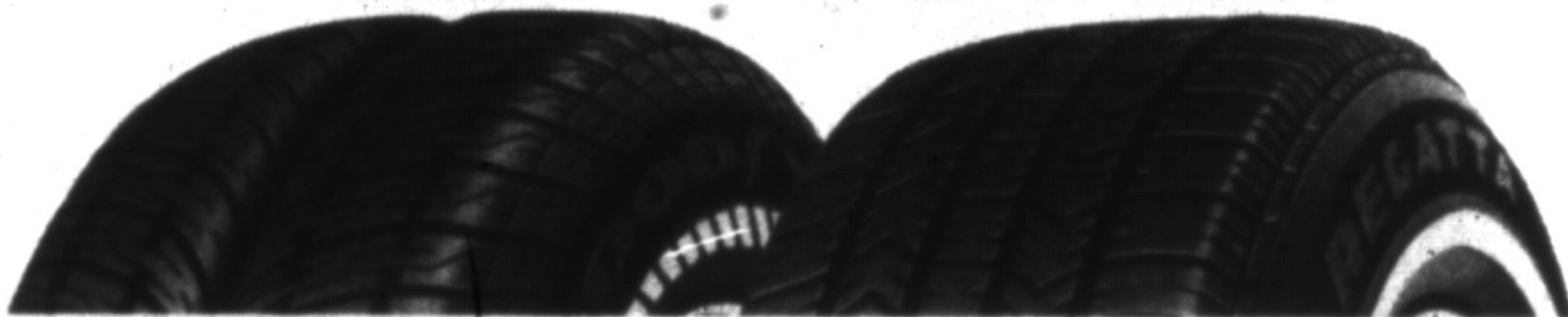
# Curlers bow out in Diamond Seniors

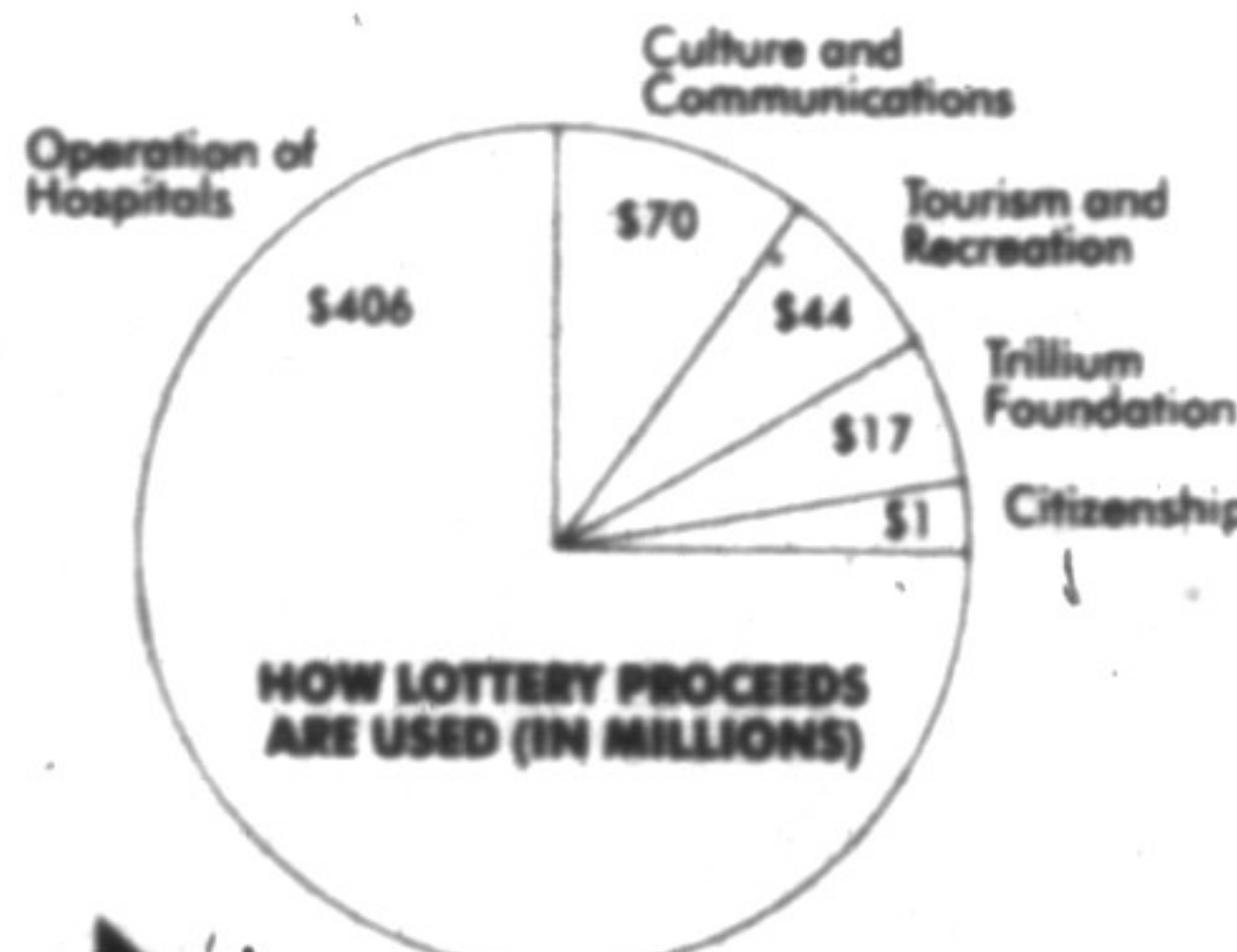
