Sincere sympathy is extended to Donna Giles and family of Niagara Falls on the recent passing of her father Delbert Downs.

Mr. Downs was predeceased by his wife Isabel Carton and daughter Shirley. Until his retirement, he was a successful farmer and custom thresher on the family's Sixth Line

A custom thresher was a most important person to a farmer in the years 1900 to 1960. A custom thresher owned and operated a larger heavy machine that separated the grain from the straw at harvest time. The machine required expertise by operators.

The machine was so hazardous that many workers lost a hand and wore a hook for the rest of their lives. The machines went from farm to farm drawn by teams of horses later by steam engines and then by tractors.

The threshing machine required two men to operate. It very quickly and efficiently separated the seed from the straw.

In about 1965, the machines became less expensive and less complicated and often farmers with large acreage owned their own. Today these machines are antiques and are on display in the museums.

The late Mr. Downs was one of the best custom people.




