

# Sarjeantson no fan of plan to centralize health care

A satellite office of a health care super-agency is not good enough for her community, according to Halton Hills regional councillor Marilyn Serjeantson.

The centralized Multi-Service Agency (MSA) has been ordered by council, elected officials endorsed a staff proposal on health care services in Halton Region. That proposal, in response to a call for ideas by the Halton District Health Council, suggested a central office and five satellites, one for each urban area in Halton.

The Burlington councillor Bob Wood said that while there was certain to

be anxiety regarding the nuts and bolts of the concept, he was sure it will work.

Council was told a deferral of the issue was not possible because the deadline for submissions of ideas is February 28.

Ms Serjeantson said she would support a second option considered by regional staff, in which each urban area had an MSA which shared resources with a central agency.

Her motion to reconsider the region's submission was defeated.

Oakville councillor Liz Behrens suggested that the region forward the entire staff report to the Halton District Health Council while highlighting the region's preference. That report outlines several options, including the option preferred by Ms Serjeantson.

That motion carried 15-7.

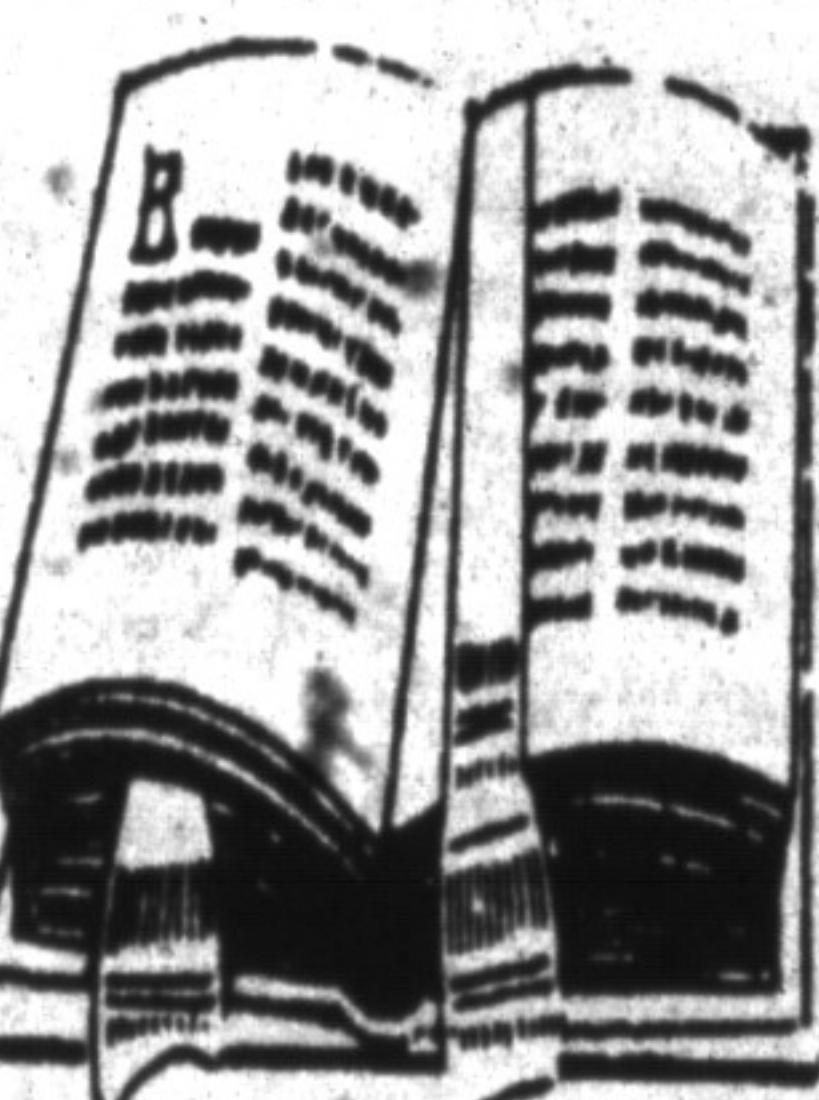
