"Evidently the understanding we naive and innocent taxpayers have of PTR needs some clarification," he said.

"If the teacher part of your PTR includes any teachers who do not teach full time, or perhaps any of the time, then it must include other

classes far above the PTR. This is a mathematical necessity because your PTR is an average.

"What we smell here is that the definition of PTR enables classroom resources to be drained off into administrative work inside the system, on one hand, while on the other hand trustees and taxpayers outside the system are forbidden to question the resulting cost. What a neat

"To say that a cost reduction is inaccessible because it is in the PTR is simply slack management," Mr. Gue warned. "Whole mighty industries, like shipbuilding on the Clyde, have been destroyed by that kind of

Mr. Gue said the board can't save \$10 million by flipping a switch, but he did ask trustees to prepare a component of the strategic plan which will, over a reasonable period of time such as three years, eliminate rigidities like the PTR, which he suggested are preventing the implementation of cost reductions exemplified in Mr. Scheel's list of proposals.

"The objective is improved scholastic results obtained at significantly lower cost, in the order of 10 per cent lower or better within the plan time frame."
