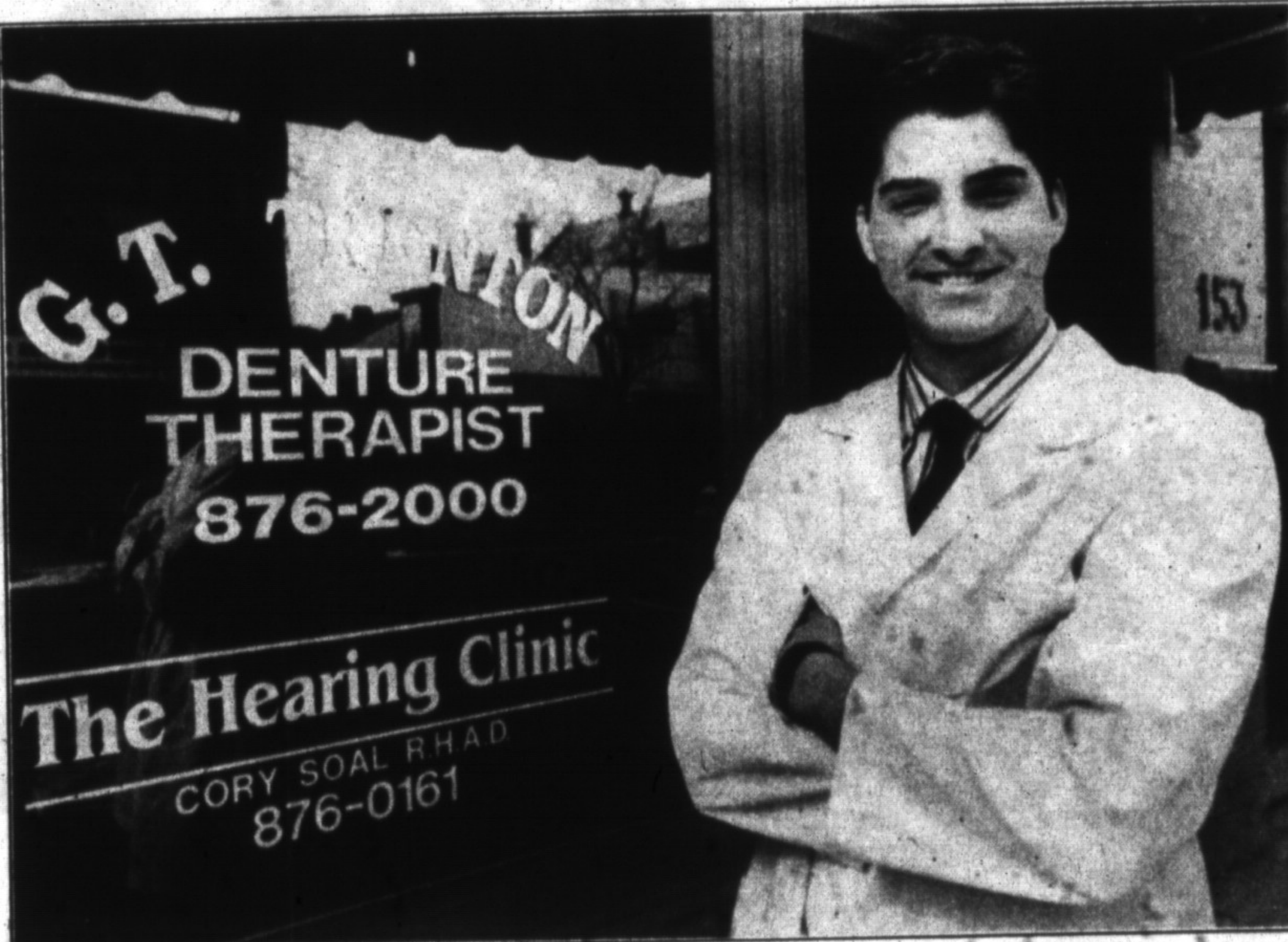
The Hearing clinic has been open to the public since November, 1993 with two convenient locations to serve you: 18 Church St., Georgetown (corner of Church & Market, inside the Denture Clinic), 873-6642 and 153 Main St. E. Milton (beside the C.I.B.C.) 876-0161.

Continually improving technology in this field now enables Hearing Aid Dispensers to fit a greater scope of hearing impaired people in much more effective ways. For example, people who previously were unable to benefit from hearing instruments can now be successfully fitted, due to the advanced prescription methods and increased quality in hearing instruments and testing procedures. Size and appearance have also been greatly reduced, thus eliminating any "vanity problems" that may have previously been attached with wearing a hearing aid.

In addition to this great new technology, everyone who is a citizen of Ontario is eligible to receive a grant (approximately 60% - 75% of the cost) towards the purchase of their new hearing aid from the Assistive Devices Program. This program is sponsored by the Ministry of Health and is allowing people who previously could not afford to buy a hearing aid, to do so now.

If you, or someone you know, might suffer from hearing loss take these steps to ensure a properly fitted hearing aid:

- Make an appointment with your family doctor and ask to be referred



returned to the dispenser who fits, counsels, repairs and services, the wearer's hearing aid for the life of the instrument.

If you already wear a hearing instrument or know someone who does, The Hearing Clinic offers service and repairs to all makes and models, custom-fitted hearing aids, as well as individually moulded water and noise attenuating ear plugs. Also every size battery is kept in stock. The Hearing Clinic carries only Pro-Line premium zinc-air batteries by Rayovac. Considered the highest quality, longest lasting batteries in the industry, Pro-Line premium zinc-air batteries are distributed solely through hearing health care professionals.

to either an audiologist or a hearing dispenser who will direct you in obtaining a hearing test.

- Make sure both of these people are registered with the Assistive Devices Program. (It means they are

recognized by the Ministry of Health in Ontario).

- An Audiologist will test your hearing and present you with a list of registered dispensers in your area. This person will take an impression

of your ear and send this, along with the prescription for your new hearing aid, to the recommended manufacturer of the audiologist's choice. The instrument is custom designed to match your specific hearing loss and

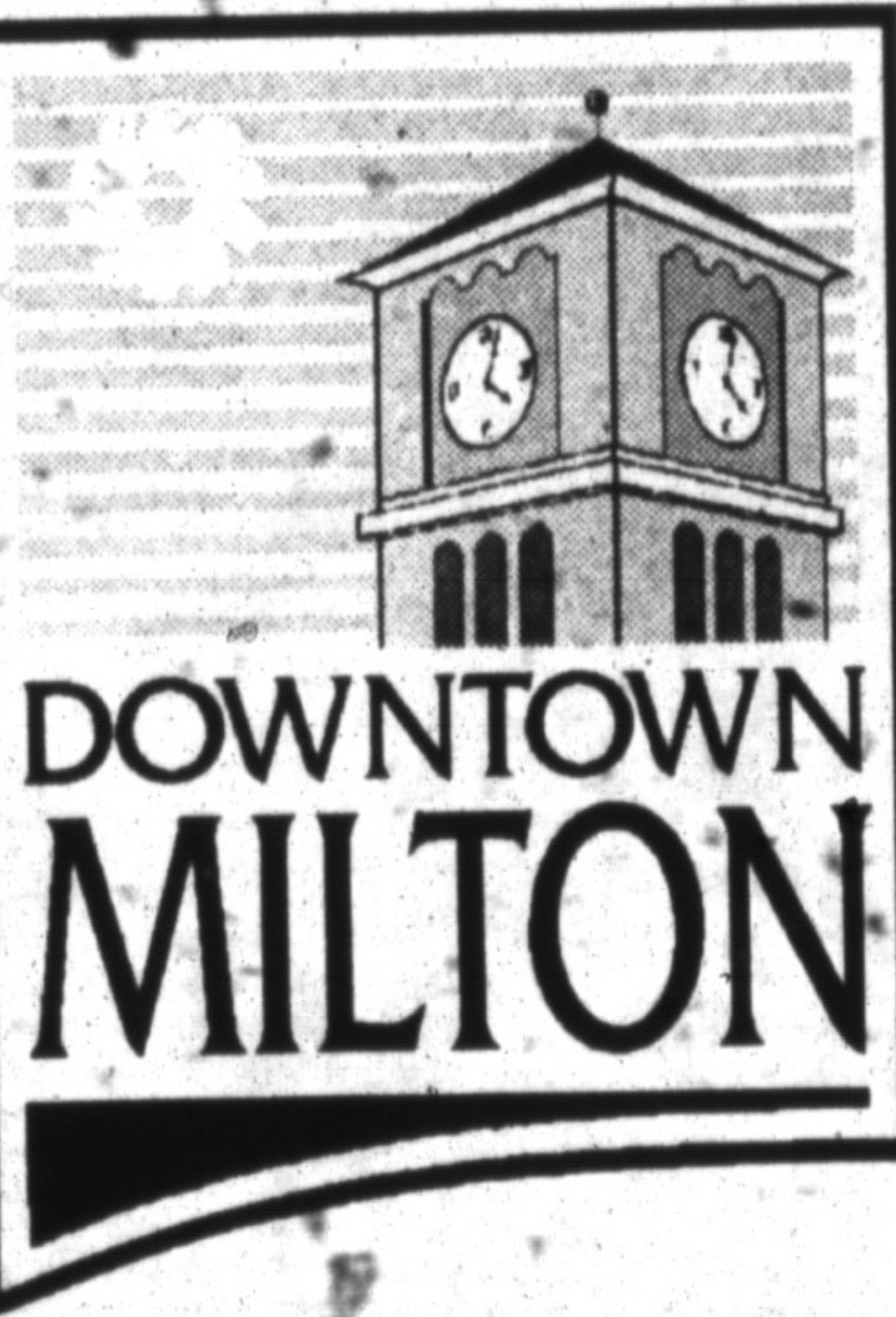
