



June 6-10-5,000 kids expected for environment fest at agricultural museum

More than 5,000 primary school children from across Ontario are expected to pass through the Ontario Agriculture Museum in Milton during the Children's Groundwater Festival, June 6-10.

The festival, transported from Nebraska to Ontario by Gerry Rich, director of responsible care for Cambridge's CIBA-Geigy chemical company, aims to inspire children to help preserve our groundwater.

Milton residents are included among the 30 per cent of Canadians who depend on groundwater for their daily needs.

"About 17 years ago we washed a chemical spill into the ground," said Mr. Rich.

"Three years ago we were doing some excavating for an expansion project and we found the remains of the stuff. The original incident happened before present-day environmental concerns. The festival is a payback because we want to be more positive towards the environment."

Mr. Rich said he was impressed while touring the festival in Nebraska, held just outside the capital, Lincoln. He added that in order to accommodate the high number of children, the festival will need nearly 100 volunteers per day to help man the 30 activity centres.

All schools in a 50-kilometre radius were notified of the festival and students from grades 4-6 invited.

Some of the exhibits at the festival will include; The Royal Flush, Well Drilling, Water Witching, Home Sweet Home and The Amazing Aquifer as students learn about water use in the home and in business.
