



them for adopting Tory-like policies of NAFTA, GATT, unemployment cuts and the GST, which he believes will be reintroduced and renamed, but remain essentially the same tax.

The Liberal failure to address the deficit will prove "conducive" to PC renewal, he predicted.

He said the Liberals should be "downright ashamed" of their autocratic style in the Pearson airport issue.

"Their historical and deeply ingrained arrogance will trip them up," he

During the question and answer period one audience member said he believed there was a great gap between what the PC party told people and what was actually delivered, particularly in its promises of smaller governments, less regulation and lower taxes.

And he commented that a significant number of protest votes went to Reform due to that gap.

"I think you are right," acknowledged Mr. Meighen. "That perception was there. We as a party allowed that to happen, and we paid dearly for it." He said Mr. Charest is looking closely at the government of Alberta Premier Ralph Klein, who the senator claimed was doing exactly what the PCs promised to do in the past.
