

## Fishing derby at Kelso

Kelso Conservation Area is busy preparing for 1994 fishing. This Saturday (Apr. 30) marks the opening of trout season. The 14th Annual Fishing Derby follows the next Saturday (May 7). These two weekends are open to fishing fanatics of all ages.

As in every year, the Kelso reservoir will be stocked with rainbow trout, some of which are more than 20 inches in length. The gatehouse will be open at 6 a.m. on the weekends of April 30 and May 7.

The fishing derby runs from 7 a.m. until 2 p.m. Registration will be held at the Kelso gatehouse, Saturday, Apr. 30 and Sunday, May 1 from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Saturday, May 7 6 a.m. to 7 a.m. The fees are \$8 for adults. Children (12 and under) and senior citizens (65 and over) pay \$6 each.

Many prizes will be provided for various categories by local businesses such as the Halton Outdoors Shop, McDonald's, Tim Horton's and Banana Boat. And you don't have to catch anything to win — registered participants are eligible to win door prizes.

All fishing diehards between the ages of 18 and 64 must have a valid Ontario fishing licence.

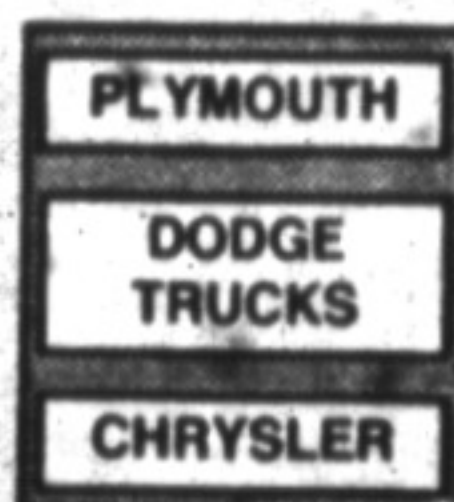
