RECIPE FILE

Try these caramelized onion and tomato pizza appetizers

Individual baked pizza crusts speed up the preparation of these easy and delicious appetizers. Spread the crusts with a simple caramelized onion mixture, top with bright, colourful Ontario greenhouse tomatoes tossed with mozzarella cheese, then bake until hot and melted.

As a host, you'll appreciate the fact that you can prepare the onions, tomatoes and cheese ahead of time, then assemble the pizzas and pop them into the oven just before serving.

- 2 large onions, thinly sliced;
- 2 tbsp (25 ml) olive oil;
- 2 tbsp (25 ml) balsamic vinegar;
- 1 tbsp (15 ml) honey;
- Salt and Pepper;
- 4 (approx. 7 in./18 cm) baked pizza crusts;
- 2 Ontario Greenhouse Tomatoes, seeded and diced;
- 2 cups (500 ml) shredded mozzarella cheese;
- Grated Parmesan cheese;
- Chopped fresh parsley;

Directions: In large nonstick frypan, saute onions in oil over

medium-high heat until limp. Reduce heat to low; simmer, uncovered, 20 min. or until onions are tender, stirring frequently. Blend in vinegar and honey. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Divide mixture among pizza crusts; spread evenly. Combine tomatoes and mozzarella cheese;

sprinkle over onion mixture. Top with Parmesan cheese. Bake on baking sheet in 350F (180C) oven 10 to 15 min. or until hot and cheese is melted. Sprinkle with parsley. Cut each pizza into six wedges. Makes 24 appetizers. Preparation time: 25 minutes. Cooking time: 15 minutes.
