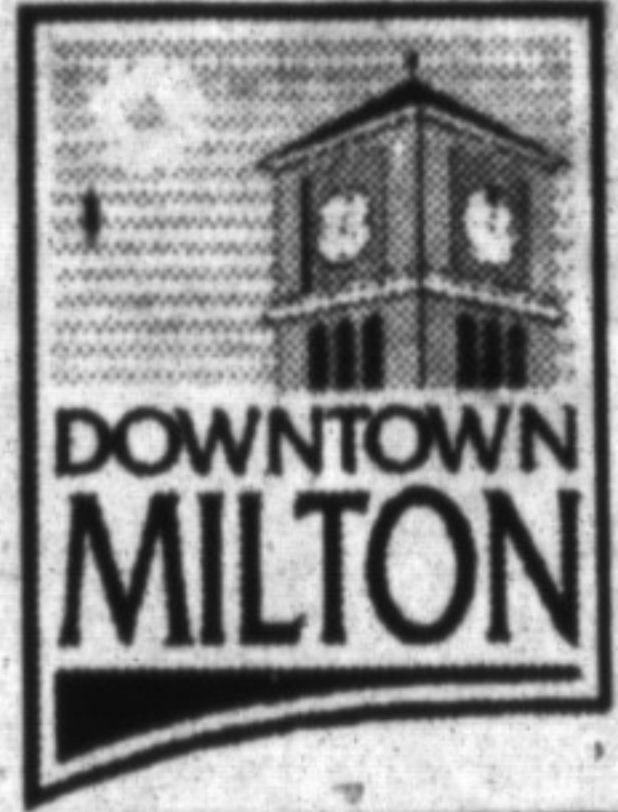

An historic event in Milton history begins tonight!

You might ask yourself, what does Milton have in common with these three major world cities? It is the art of Ely Bielutin. Starting tonight at 7:00 p.m., the Dorland-Haight Gallery of Milton, will be hosting an art show and sale featuring Russian abstractionist Ely Bielutin, and his former student Sophie Schiller. Both will be in attendance at the show opening throughout the weekend (June 24, 25, 26).

"Ely Bielutin is extremely important for two reasons," said gallery owner Peter Haight. "First, his art, and for his art combined with history. Historically, he represents half the world in abstract art."

"Ely Bielutin is the only abstract artist to survive and run a school in the Soviet Union from the time of Stalin to Gorbachev," explained Mr. Haight.

Bielutin founded School of New

Reality (The Bielutiners) after the death of Stalin. This school was the only one in existence outside government-approved organizations; in fact, the only one to teach abstractionism from the period between Stalin and Gorbachev. Bielutin's school was unique!

In 1962, when the school participated in a Soviet government-sponsored exhibit in Manege Hall near Red Square, Nikita Khrushchev, angered upon viewing the work, forbade Bielutin and his school access to the Artists' Union. "Ely was forced to go outside Moscow and go underground. He remained there for 30 years," said Mr. Haight. Before the Soviet collapse in 1991, Ely, through the aid of friends, sold his works in Warsaw, Italy, Vienna and Paris.

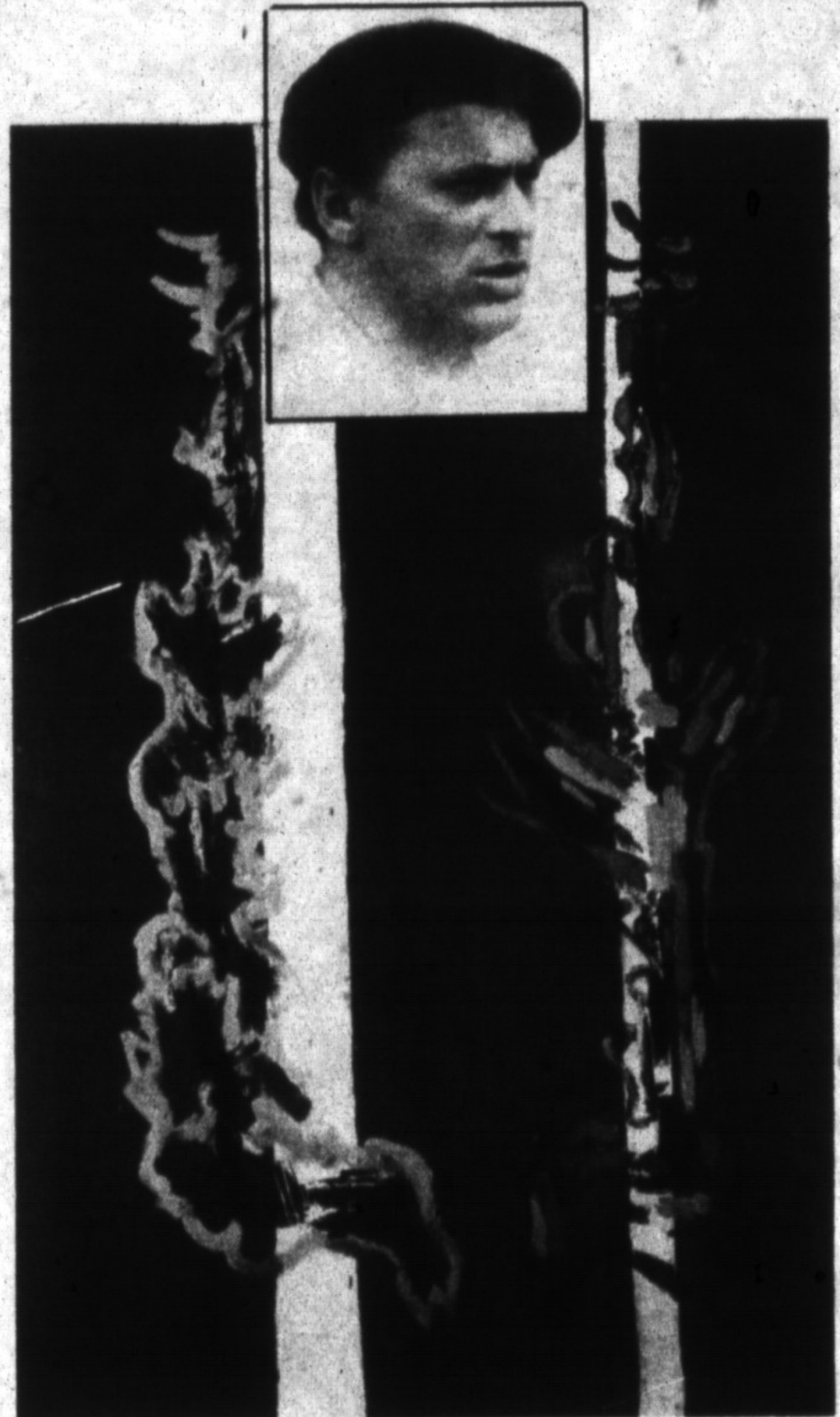
The Dorland-Haight Galleries now has exclusive rights for Bielutin's art in North America.

In addition to the work of Ely Bielutin, Sophie Schiller, the

most outstanding of Bielutin's former students will be present to show her many works. At age 22 Ms. Schiller was relegated, with other Bielutiners to the back alleys and secreted studios of Moscow.

One of Ms. Schiller's paintings "Landscape in Gray" was confiscated after being personally criticized by the Premier. In 1974 Sophie was finally able to emigrate to the United States, but again, not with her paintings. Happily, again, through the help of friends, she managed to have some of her canvasses brought out; among them, "Landscape in Gray". This very painting will be at the gallery for the show.

This show and sale will be at the Dorland-Haight Galleries, located in downtown Milton at 200 Main Street East, and runs from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. tonight, June 24 and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, June 25 and 26.
