The Waltzing Weasel has come to Downtown Milton! The restaurant has been open since June 1, and many people have noticed.



The banquet room is licensed for 150 people, the downstairs for 87 (which is available for bookings), and another 86 on the patio. There is a dart area which will be occasionally used for entertainment on weekends, as well as a giant screen TV (that many soccer fans have come to know in the past month).

For the more serious diners and families the Waltzing Weasel is also for you! Doug Ranch is the first to admit his "pride in Chef Erik Kjaer". The Waltzing Weasel is hosting its Grand Opening this Saturday, July 9. Entertainment gets underway from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the patio (weather permitting) and 9:00 p.m. till 1:00 a.m. inside.

As well as the entertainment there will be a pid roast, which is a tradition from the Waltzing Weasel in Oshawa. The roast will be served around 5:00 p.m. with plates going for \$4.95 (including salads). If you come earlier in the day you can sit out on the patio with a beer and talk to Maradona (the pig.)
