

# Vehicle nails mail

Nine mail boxes were destroyed and \$1,800 damage was caused when a vehicle crashed into them on Derry Road overnight Friday, Halton Regional Police say.

Police believe a vehicle travelling westbound, west of Bell School Line, hit the north-side mail boxes sometime during the night.

Both the boxes and posts were extensively damaged, says Inspector Keith Gregory. "It appears that they have been hit by a car or some other type of vehicle."
