Halton Regional Police in Milton are looking for the thief or thieves who recently absconded with a Case backhoe valued at \$16,000.

Sometime overnight June 23 to 24, a 1985 Case backhoe was stolen from Lower Base Line and Trafalgar Road in Milton. The backhoe is bright orange, in good condition, with new front tires and a dent on the hood by the windshield.

It is easily identified by the company sticker 'Fusillo Group Limited' that was on the driver's door when stolen. The backhoe forks are marked with the lettering 'Marta Sales Equipment.'

Police do not know whether the backhoe was 'hot wired' or suspects used a key. No witnesses have yet come forward and police would appreciate your assistance in locating the machinery and the culprits.
