Project cost up \$100,000

A recovering economy has helped tag an extra \$100,000 onto the cost of a watermain upgrade for Derry Road, east of Tremaine Road to Bell School Line.

The \$363,000 upgrade involves the fitting of polyethylene piping into the watermain, total replacement of a portion of the main and replacement of all watermain valves. Work on the project, which has been on the books since late 1992, could start this month if regional council, as expected, approves a related tender Wednesday.

month to complete and regional staff reported area water users will be provided a temporary water supply.

Burlington Councillor Bob Brechin grilled public works staff about the jump in cost at Wednesday's planning and public works committee.

The committee heard \$40,000 of the increased costs came from the need to replace, rather than line, a portion of the watermain, while the additional \$60,000 represented higher contractor prices.

Regional public works commissioner Art Leitch said it's possible contractors were actually losing money on some projects during the The upgrade is expected to take a recession, just to keep their equipment and employees working. "The trend coming out of the recession is to increased costs on contracts."
