## She probes family past

Today, four books have been published and she's now working on revising the first.

Her first book, *Mayflower Increasing's*, was published in 1989. It is a complete revision of John Landis' *Mayflower Descendants and Their Marriages for Two Generations After the Landing*.

*Mayflower Increasing's* includes a summary of all that is currently known about passengers of the Mayflower for the first three generations in America — names, dates, places, spouses, children and more.

Next, Mrs. Roser wrote *Mayflower Marriages*, the records of 10,000 marriages spanning five centuries with names, dates and sources, which hit the market in 1990.

Her third book, *Mayflower Births and Deaths*, a two-volume collection, was published in 1992. It features a compilation of birth and death records.

Most recently, Mrs. Roser authored *Mayflower Deeds and Probates*, predictably including deeds and probate records of the Mayflower settlers.

Following hundreds of hours of research, Mrs. Roser said she considers herself to have become quite knowledgeable in the area of genealogy and has helped others trace their family histories.

"A lot of people want to do their genealogy, but they don't know where to start," she said. "This is the kind of thing that you learn as you go."

The key to success is persistence, she said. Mrs. Roser, who didn't even know her grandparents' names

when she started, began seeking information by writing letters to relatives, and then she approached the archives.

"I think I bombarded the Nova Scotia archives for five years with monthly letters," she said. "Once you start to get involved in it, you get hooked."

Mrs. Roser is also an active member of the Canadian Society of Mayflower Descendants, an organization open to descendants of passengers on the ship.

## Judge warns Charlie Currie

Mr. Currie was also convicted of breach of recognizance for writing cheques contrary to a condition set when he was released on bail in the Beckstead matter March 9.

"He went out and merrily disregarded that," said Judge LeSage. "He wrote cheques. He wrote 30 of them."

Taking into consideration the six months Mr. Currie has spent in prison since being arrested March 26, the judge sentenced him to two years and three months in penitentiary for the Marion fraud.

He also received a nine-month sentence for writing the bad cheque to Mrs. Beckstead, and six months for the breach of probation, both to be served concurrently.

For the breach of recognizance conviction, however, he was handed a nine-month consecutive jail term.

The sentence also included a compensation order of \$23,000 to Mr. Marion.

Court heard Mr. Currie has an extensive criminal record including several fraud convictions and impaired driving.

"It's a sad story," the judge continued. "Mr. Currie just doesn't seem to learn."

His speech ended with a plea for Mr. Currie to "go straight and be honest."

"I have nothing further to say to you. Good luck and, please change your ways."
