Milton's three Ward 1/3 Halton Board of Education trustee candidates had a mixed reaction on learning the Halton Taxpayers' Coalition has publicly endorsed one of them.

The Burlington-based Coalition threw its weight behind Tim Kingsbury over Nancy Taylor and Sarita Purdy, in a recent news release.
