

Light up a life by buying a bulb

You can light up a life — maybe even of someone you know — by buying a bulb.

Proceeds from the Milton District Hospital Foundation's fourth annual 'Buy a Bulb Campaign' will go toward the purchase of two patient lift systems for the chronic care unit of the Derry Road hospital. The foundation is aiming to raise \$15,000 in the campaign, which includes prizes for donors.

A donation of \$150 or more lights a large string of Christmas lights. First-year donors in this price range will receive the 'Partridge in the Pear Tree' ornament. Second-year donors will take home the 'Two Turtledoves' ornament. Third-year donors will be given 'Three French Hens' from the third verse of the famous song, and four-year donors will earn the 'Four Calling Birds' ornament.

A donation in the \$50 to \$149 range will light a small string of lights. First-year donors will receive a silver and blue, tree-shaped ornament. Second-year donors will get a blue and gold bell-shaped ornament. Third-year donors will be presented a silver and blue dove-shaped ornament, and fourth-year donors will receive a red and gold candle-shaped ornament.

Donors of \$10 will light a single light and will receive a fuzzy Santa Claus or snowman-shaped ornament.

All donors can win a hand-crafted wooden sled, which has been donated to the foundation. Donations must reach the foundation office by Tuesday, Dec. 20 to qualify for the sled, which is valued at \$500. The winning entry will be drawn at the hospital on December 20.

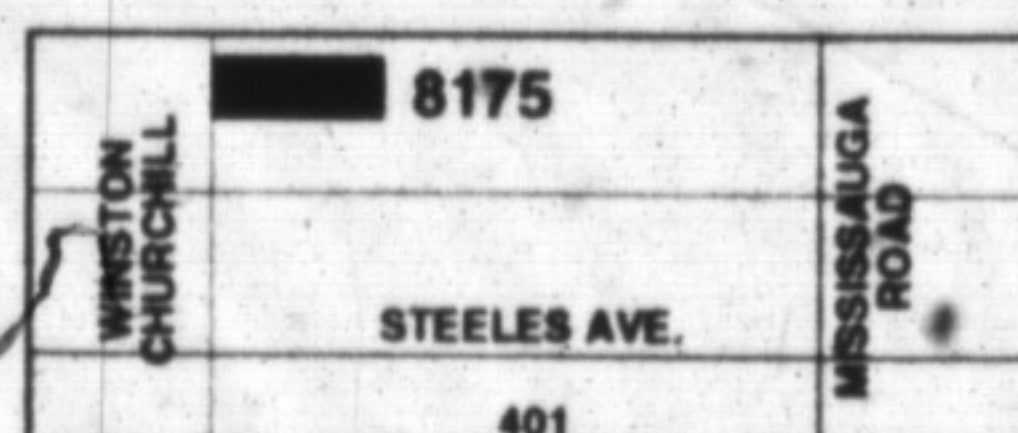
