Show features info on passing torch with farm

A television special airing this month is recommended viewing for rural families.

Carried on the BBS network in two Saturday parts, January 14 and 21, "Between Generations" could help shed some light on the question of passing the family farm down to the younger generation.

Seen locally on CFTO in Toronto at 11:30 a.m., the show will be repeated on February 11 and 18 at 10 a.m. on CKCO in Kitchener.

The program explores planning for the future, including practical decisions and tax implications. Using a farm family which has been through the process, the show features advice from several professionals including a lawyer, accountant, retirement planner, banker and the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs.

The local ministry office will also lend a video tape of the show, plus a second tape with extended interviews with various professionals.

Farm families can also take part in a two-day workshop on the topic, which will take place Tuesday, Feb. 27 and Tuesday, Mar. 5 at the ministry office in Georgetown from 9:30 a.m. through 3:30 p.m.

Those interested in the tape or registering in the workshop should call 1-800-461-6184. The workshop costs \$40 per person and includes lunch. Two people from the same farm can attend for \$55.
