If you haven't already sent your application in, send it now because

the deadline is the end of March.

If you didn't receive your renewal form in the mail, contact your nearest Human Resource Centre of Canada. Pensioners who do not complete and return the form may have their pensions reduced to the

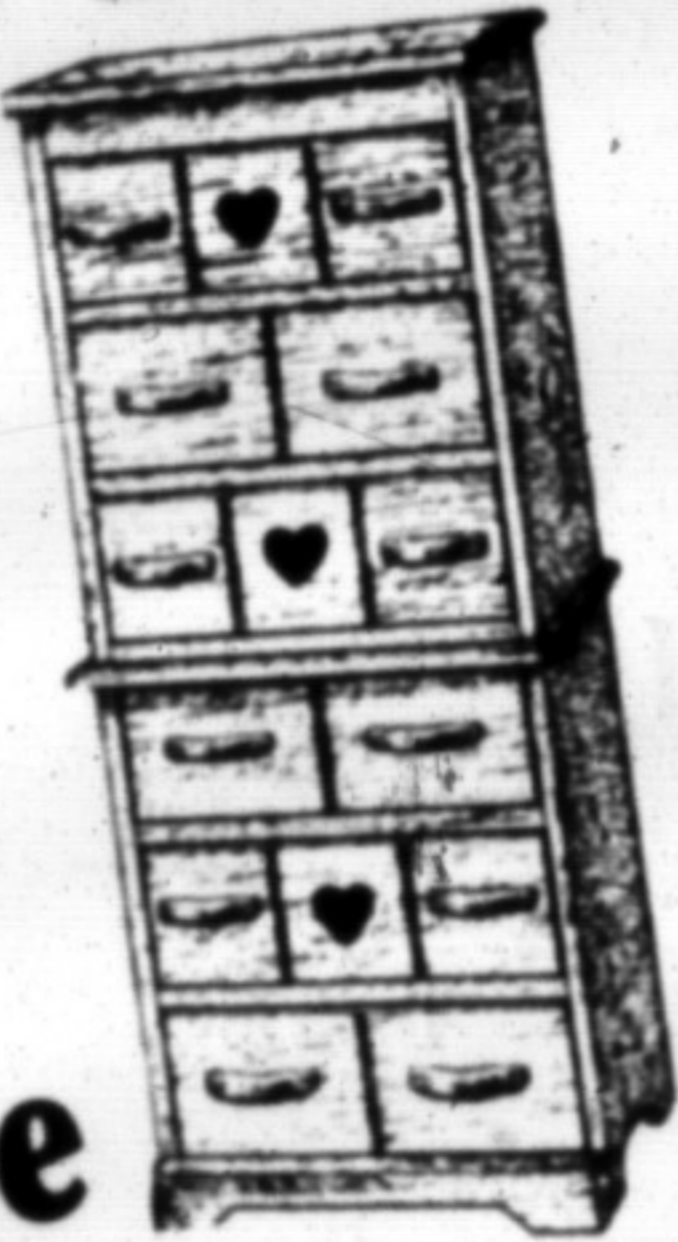
basic old age security amount.
