Scott Early nominated for Citizen of the Year

Scott Early's sensitivity and compassion as a funeral director as well as his commitment to the community have put him in the running for the town's top honour.

The 37-year-old operator of the J. Scott Early Funeral Home on James Street has been nominated for 1995 Citizen of the Year.

The humble Milton native's reaction was shock and he questioned why he was nominated for such an honour.

"I go about my work everyday. I guess you don't realize that people notice what you do," he said. "Where would society be without volunteers? You don't expect any reward."

His nominator said he has witnessed Mr. Early's "deep compassion and sensitivity" on the job and his commitment to volun-

teer work with the Lions Club, Masonic Lodge and as a baseball coach.

"I have observed an underlying spirit of determination to serve one's fellow citizen, whatever the personal cost," his nominator said. "This spirit is also reflected in his work with respect to bereavement seminars, which have helped many within the community."

Mr. Early, a husband and father of two girls, opened the J. Scott Early Funeral Home nine years ago after working in the business with the McKersie Funeral Home for several years.

He felt there was need for two funeral homes in town, he said. Mr. Early takes his work seriously.

"It's not just a job. It can't be just a job," he said. "It has to come from the heart."

Local real estate agent Betty Ingle and volunteer Dickie Deumer have also been nominated for Citizen of the Year.
