"He's a nice colt but is still very green and learning his manners," Brown said after the race. "This is a good series for him to start his three year-old season

Owned by Lothlorien Equestrian Centre of Mississauga, Hare Hare races from the Bill Robinson stable. He was close to a length better than Broadcast, driven by Treyor Ritchie, with Benfica third in rein to Dave Wall.

Brown had a driving double in the Series' first leg. also scoring in 1:58 with Waltster. This Walton Hanover-First Abroad colt is trained by Dave Green for Jumble Stable of Tottenham, Ontario. Waltster hauled down the pace-setting Sourire in the closing strides, with Big Boy Dexter third.

Park Twon Plaza, a Big Towner-Missy Robin colt, was the fastest of the division winners in 1:57.1. Dave Vance trains this winner for Dask Realty Trust of

The fourth division went to Brittany Farms' Town Prophet. The Jate Lobell-Authentic colt, trained by Bob McIntosh and driven by Steve Condren, controlled the pace from the quarter the rest of the way to score under wraps in 1:58.2. Town Prophet won the Count B series final at Woodbine on January 19, and bested Whittler and Bobs Bunny in this one.

McIntosh and Condren teamed up again for Brittany Farms to win the \$35,000 Free For All on the same March 23 card with Make A Deal. The No Nukes-Leah Almahurst five year-old carried favored Camtastic Dream to the quarter in :27, then sat second over behind Horan Hanover and came by in the stretch to win in 1:54.1 over Ash Blue Chip and Music Director.

Triple T-Storm turned in an eye-catching 1:56 win in the March 18th Free For All trot, a Canadian season's record. The Triple T Crown-Triple Misty six year-old was taken on March 3rd by trainer and coowner Doug Berkeley out of a \$60,000 claimer, and he downed Dell Ridge Image and Hay Dude for his 42nd career win with Tony Kerwood at the lines. A week previous at Woodbine, Triple T Storm had taken a mark of 1:55.3. This win pushed Triple T Storm's, lifetime earnings to more than \$250,000.




