

# Cops will be showing their stuff *Dateline*

Milton will be the home of National Police Week activities next week.

The week of May 12 to 18 will be celebrated by law enforcement agencies across Canada.

In Milton, Halton Regional Police will set up a display at Milton Mall from Thursday to Saturday, said Sgt. Frank Phillips.

Police will be on hand at the display, which will be open during mall hours.

"The event allows police services to get out into their communities and tell the public just what it is they do on a daily basis," he said.

Members of community groups such as Crime

Prevention Ontario, the Victim Services Unit and the Milton Community Consultation Committee, along with other enforcement agencies, will also be on hand to answer the public's questions.

A popular event, Operation Snapshot, will be part of the display, Sgt. Phillips said. For a donation to the Ontario Special Olympics, visitors can dress up as a police officer and have their picture taken in a cruiser or the force's Harley-Davidson motorcycle.

"We encourage everyone to come out and meet the men and women in blue who serve you, and to find out more about programs available in your community," Sgt. Phillips said.
