

TAX SAVINGS & DIVERSIFICATION

Oil & natural gas limited partnerships (or LPs) offer investors tax deductions in the year of purchase and tax preferred quarterly cash flow of up to 10% tax-free per year. The LPs purchase producing gas and oil proprietors in Western Canada. The investor receives 85% of the revenue from the sale of the oil and gas. The North Sea, Gulf of Mexico and Alaska are at or past their peak production. New supplies are much more expensive to produce in Hibernia or the Tar Sands.
