After the meeting Ms Savoline said opponents to HUSP are "fear-mongering" by bringing in perceived threats to the taxpayer. She said their concerns are not supported by facts. Halton Region has no obligation to move ahead with HUSP unless councillors are satisfied with the proposals, she added.

The private sector, which has shown strong interest, would not be trying to get involved in the project if the risks were not manageable, Ms Savoline said.

As to Mr. Scholtens' concern about commercial and industrial growth, Ms Savoline pointed to the huge frontages of industrial land on Highway 401 and Highway 407 West which will be created with new water servicing.

The measure calling for an investigation of Peel's proposal and naming the shortlisted consortiums still has to pass full regional council today (Wednesday). If it does, the call for detailed proposals from the shortlisted companies will come in early September.
