Local cadets do well in sailing meet

A Milton sailing team claimed second place earlier this month in the 1996 Ontario Provincial Sea Cadet Sailing Regatta at Lake Conestoga, near Kitchener.

Petty officer first class Allan De Rabbie and petty officer first class Kevin Gallant manned the vessel which claimed the prize.

Eleven teams took part, trying to earn the honour of representing the province at the Canadian National Sea Cadet Sailing Regatta at Trois Rivieres, Quebec beginning August 19.

The top five finishers will compete with top sailors from five regions across the country.

Cadets up to 19 years of age who have attained sufficient sailing experience are qualified to compete.

These sailors must qualify at local and regional levels to earn a berth in the provincial regatta for petrel class sailboats.

The regatta was hosted by Guelph cadets and sponsored by The Department of National Defense, with more than 40 escort officers and staff on hand to provide guidance and assistance to competing teams.

Rash of thefts involving cars in urban area; cops

Motorists should be on the lookout. A large number of thefts of cars and thefts from cars have been reported in the Milton area, Halton Regional Police said.

Four cars were stolen from the front of people's homes and from apartment building parking lots over the June 15-16 weekend. Vehicles were taken from Ontario Street and Millside Drive apartment complex parking lots, the front of a Mill Street home and a Maiden Lane driveway.

"I think there's a small group of people that are committing these thefts," said Staff Sgt. Roy Smith.

A Chevrolet Lumina believed to have been stolen overnight Friday from a Syer Drive residence was recovered on Fifth Line at No. 17 Sideroad. The vehicle had been set on fire and gutted, police said.

Items such as cellular phones, compact discs, stereos, wallets and purses were also stolen from unlocked cars parked on Thomas Street, Valleyview Crescent, Sunnyvale Crescent, Woodlawn Crescent and Laurier Avenue.

Staff Sgt. Smith warned car owners that leaving property in plain view in an unlocked car is inviting thieves. "This type of crime is picking up for the summer," he said. "It's a crime of opportunity."

Youths help police nab drunken man

Youths helped police arrest a man who allegedly ran from an officer shortly after 9 p.m. Saturday.

A man seen staggering and carrying a gas can at Derry and Ontario streets ran away

when an officer tried to speak with him, police said.

The youths managed to grab the fleeing suspect and hold onto him until police caught up. One of the youths was assaulted during the incident.

A 40-year-old Third Line man faces charges of being intoxicated in a public place and assault.

Erratic motorist drives on sidewalk

A Ford Explorer drove down a Milton sidewalk as police tried to pull over the vehicle early Saturday morning.

The vehicle was seen travelling erratically at Barton and Bell streets shortly after 2:30 a.m. Police attempted to pull over the truck, but it didn't stop right away, Staff Sgt. Smith said.

Charged with impaired driving and failing to stop for police is a 32-year-old Toronto man.

Inmate charged in sex assault

A female correctional officer was sexually assaulted by a Maplehurst inmate at the Martin Street institution early in the morning of June 15, police said.

The jail guard was "groped a couple times," Staff Sgt. Smith said.

Charged with sexual assault is a 20-year-old Toronto man.
