## Investment Structure Saves Tax

The way we set up our investments has a lot to do with the amount of income tax we pay. Capital gains and dividends are taxed at lower rates than interest. If you have investments inside and outside an RSP it makes more sense to have interest bearing investments tax sheltered inside and dividend and capital gain investments outside.

Married couples can save taxes by having interest and dividends held by the lower tax bracket spouse and capital gains by the higher bracket spouse. If \$1000 of interest can be taxed at 27% versus 50% you get to keep a lot more of it.

Try to make the interest you pay when borrowing tax deductible. Borrowing for investment purposes is tax deductible while borrowing for personal purchases, i.e. a car, is not. Investments should be sold and the cash used to buy the car. Borrow the money you were going to use for the car and buy your investments. Depending on your tax rate this will reduce your after tax borrowing costs by 27% to 50%.

These three structural changes don't change what you own; just the amount of tax you pay:
