She will now work alongside golf pro Jefferson Davis, who also has 16 years experience in the sport. After an apprenticeship at the Toronto Golf Club, he spent time at such clubs as South Brooks, Scenic Woods and Greystone as well.

This club is designed for all types of public use," said Davis. "While we are operational, we're still making some last minute changes including final renovations on our clubhouse and banquet facilities. We'll be fully functional by the start of

August. All this spring rain has hindered our progress."

The club was designed by renowned golf course architect Rene Muylaert, who has created numerous courses across western Ontario, including Nobleton Links and Indian Wells. Granite Ridge is a par 70/71 course built over 6,000 yards.

It features seven ponds and a creek running throughout.

"One of the nice things about this club is that the creek runs through four holes on the course. With most holes played

towards the escarpment, there's a beautiful view as well," Davis explained.

The course offers tee blocks for novice, intermediate and advanced golfers and has a nice mix of short and long distance holes. "It's a good, challenging course for the everyday player," added Davis.

While still too early to have a signature hole yet, the 18th could become Granite Ridge's calling card. It's a dogleg right, par four played over two ponds that challenges serious competitors on the first shot, as well as with a narrow green.

One hole that could be considerably easier is number eight, where one local golfer sank a hole-in-one fust two days after the club opened.

Completing the club's atmosphere will be full locker-room facilities, riding carts and The Albatross Restaurant and Banquet Hall.

"We'll be available for banquets, weddings and board meetings. We're also hoping to offer complementary club cleaning soon," said Caravaggio.







