More vehicle thefts and damage

A rash of vehicle thefts has hit Milton and surrounding areas this month, according to police.

The latest occurrence came on July 25 when police found a 1995 Ford Bronco engulfed in flames on 10 Sideroad in Milton at approximately 1 a.m. The vehicle, which was destroyed, had been stolen earlier that evening from the Burlington area.

Three other vehicles were stolen from Milton, one of which was also torched. This incident happened between 9:30 p.m. and midnight on July 21 when a 1986 GMC was removed from a 10 Sideroad residence. It was taken to Guelph via Hwy. 401 and later burned six kilometres east of exit 299. It was also destroyed.

A beige 1989 Mac 600 tractor was stolen from a Bronte Road residence sometime overnight July 21-22, while a red 1987 Cherokee was removed from Cabot Trail overnight on July 20-21.

Neither vehicle has been recovered. The licence plate number of the Cherokee is

578 YTJ while the tractor's serial number is 814.

In light of these thefts, Staff Sergeant Jackie Gordon is encouraging area residents to register with the police CAT (Combat Auto Theft) program. Those who rarely drive between the hours of 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. can sign up to get a special decal placed on their car.

If the police spot this vehicle being driven between these hours they will stop it and verify the driver's licence and registration.

Vehicles damaged

In addition to stolen vehicles, three other cars were damaged in Milton recently.

A driver's side window was smashed on a 1988 Isuzu Trooper parked at 50 Market Drive at approximately 3:30 p.m. last Friday.

A group of teenagers were reportedly seen in the area around the time of the incident.

A 1990 Chevy GEO sustained scratches to both sides and its hood while parked at 70 Garden Lane near Rotary Park last Wednesday. The damage occurred sometime between 7 a.m. and 5:50 p.m.

Scratches were also discovered on a vehicle parked near Mary and Charles streets on the morning of July 13, while the owner visited the local Farmers' Market. The damage, which included passenger side door scratches and a dented front bumper, was estimated at \$957.

Stolen stereo

A CD-player and 15 compact discs were removed from a Laurier Drive residence sometime between 10 p.m. July 25 and 3 p.m. July 26, police report.

With no point of entry and various house guests coming and going throughout the week, the incident is not being considered a break-in.
