Hutt is every inch a king at Stratford

King Lear is perhaps the greatest tragedy ever written. King Lear is about family relationships, old age, and the nature of influence. Of all of Shakespeare's tragedies, perhaps only Hamlet comes close to cutting the same broad swath.

The production at this year's Stratford Festival, the first at the Festival since 1988, stars one of Canada's greatest stage actors, William Hutt. Last year the 75-year-old Mr. Hutt carried *The Merry Wives of Windsor* with a truly amazing performance. However, King Lear plumbs much deeper emotions than that pleasant bit of comic farce.

The Play's The Thing

Perhaps Mr. Hutt has trained for this role all his life. The audience is in for a treat thanks to his highly-believable performance. My sole criticism is that the play carries so much weight that it is impossible to absorb in only three hours. Only one of the play's multiple themes would serve to keep an audience entranced.

Dividing up his kingdom to settle into a quiet retirement, Lear is jolted to realize he no longer commands respect from two of his three daughters. They demand more concessions from him and usurp his position. His third daughter Cordelia he banishes, when she said her love for the king was self-evident, rather than delivering an eloquent declaration of fealty.

Sibling relations are also explored between half brothers of the Duke of Gloucester, one of whom convinces the Duke the other is planning to kill him. It all makes for a somewhat confusing plot, but the Stratford production, using some inspired costuming work, helps keep it straight. Lear is the crowning achievement of Shakespeare's canon. Aye, every inch the king.

On the five curtain scale, King Lear at the Stratford Festival gets four and a half curtains.

King Lear is playing at the Stratford Festival through November 2. Tickets cost between \$46.75 and \$55.75 and can be purchased with a credit card by calling 1-800-567-1600. There are several package deals, including two-for-one Tuesdays and bargains for families, students and seniors.
