recreation," he said. "It's a long-range goal." HRCA officials recently turned down a motion to look at the possibility of a snowboarding trial period during off-peak hours next season — killing the issue for the second time in two years.

Concerned about the safety of ski area users, the Halton Region Conservation Authority (HRCA) once again voted down a call to allow the growing recreation on the slopes of Glen Eden. Mr. Rayner once again requested the introduction of snowboarding at the May meeting of the HRCA's Conservation Areas/Community Relations Advisory Board.

The HRCA intends to make room for snowboarding in a future expansion, however, uncertain financial times have postponed such plans, he said. "We're quite aware that snowboarding is a growth
