## Snowboarders still frozen out

Snowboarding at Glen Eden Ski Area remains in a deep freeze.\*

Concerned about the safety of ski area users, the Halton Region Conservation Authority (HRCA) once again voted down a call to allow the growing recreation on the slopes of Glen Eden. Authority officials feel snowboarders and skiers must be segregated, but there's no room for snowboarders at the popular skill area, said HRCA chair Brian Penman.

The HRCA intends to make room for snowboarding in a future expansion, however, uncertain financial times have postponed such plans, he said.

"We're quite aware that snowboarding is a growth

recreation," he said. "It's a long-range goal."

HRCA officials recently turned down/a motion to look at the possibility of a snowboarding trial period during off-peak hours next season — killing the issue for the second time in two years.

The HRCA's position on the issue remains the same as it was in 1994 when Oakville resident Vert Rayner initially requested the move. At that time the authority's feeling, according to HRCA records, was "the authority not implement snowboarding at Glen Eden Ski Area at this time, but that integration of the activity be considered in the expansion planning for the ski area." Mr. Rayner once again requested the introduction of snowboarding at the May meeting of the HRCA's Conservation Areas/Community Relations Advisory Board.






