fee be charged in order to encourage the industry to use locations in Ontario. However, when the municipality decides it should have a staff member on hand the costs should be picked up by the film company. The OFDC also recommends a security deposit and insurance coverage be in place prior to any filming.

Milton Councillor John Challinor said the guidelines

should be forwarded to film companies upon their first contact with Milton officials and the provisions included as part of the town's normal procedure. He directed town staff to study the guidelines to see if there are any areas which need further attention.

The OFDC also believes business associations should be notified of any filming and traffic stoppages be kept to a minimum with police supervision.

WHAT IS YOUR MOST VALUABLE ASSET?

If you are self employed this type of protection is essetial. Most self-employed individuals have no group insurance plans to rely on. And even if they do, the definition of disability may not provide enough protection.


