- In-season refunds will be pro-rated accordingly.

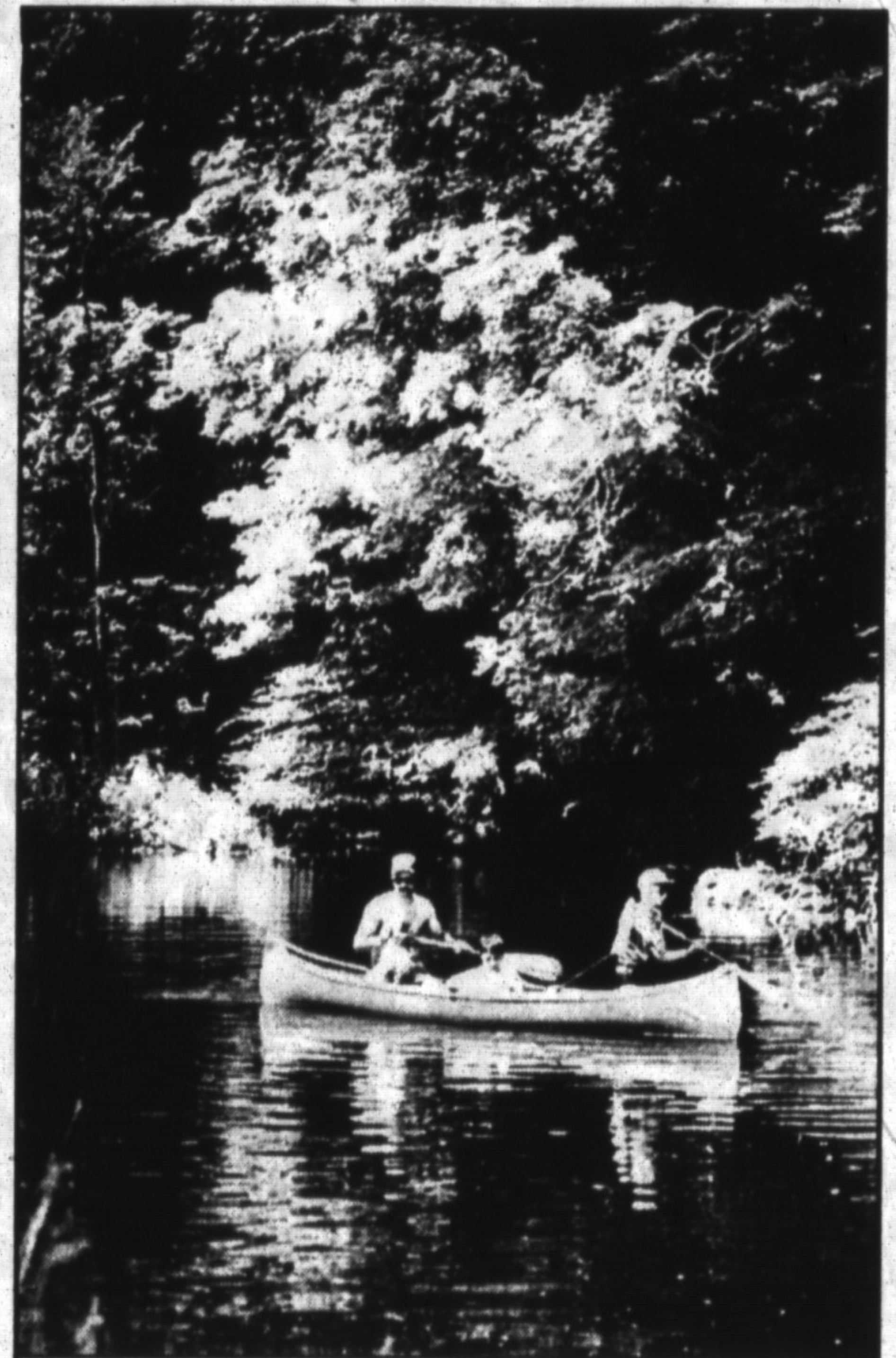

Local board real estate on internet.

Milton, Oakville and surrounding area real estate properties are now on the internet, thanks to the efforts of the Oakville, Milton and District Real Estate Board.

"Going on line provides unprecedented exposure for sellers and buyers of homes in the Oakville and Milton area," said Yvonne Ratigan, president of the Oakville, Milton and District Real Estate Board. "All the basic information you need is at your disposal with the click of a mouse."

Property information includes specifications for each property as well as high resolution color images.

The Multiple Listing Service (MLS) on line service is located on the world wide web at <http://www.mls.ca>. It is also accessible through the Microsoft Network.

Peter Tulloch, director for the board's MLS program, said the on line service will provide another venue to market properties.

"This is one of the more genuine applications on the internet. We are now hooked up with other boards and area properties are exposed world-wide," he said.

Over 1,400 Oakville and Milton area properties are already carried on the site.

"We've recently learned that since the on line properties program began, there have been 2.74 million hits on it and that the number is increasing all the time. While not everyone has internet access yet, that number represents an awfully high demand for this service," added Mr. Tulloch.
