Motorcycle ride for charity

Hundreds of motorcycles will roar westward down Highway 401 on Saturday in the fourth annual Ontario Chamber of Commerce Motorcycle Ride for the Prevention of Child Abuse.

The ride will grow in force as it moves from Toronto to Windsor with riders joining along the way. Local riders can join the group at a stop in the Canadian Tire parking lot on Highway 25 at about 9 a.m. All proceeds will go to support the Invest in Kids Foundation, a non-profit organization founded as a fundraising focus for programs that help stop child abuse before it happens.

"Children are the key to every community's future," said Pat Palmer, past president of the Ontario Chamber of Commerce and an avid motorcyclist.

Previous rides averaged 500 riders and raised about \$100,000 for child abuse prevention.

This year it begins at SkyDome at 8:30 a.m. It will

gather groups of riders in Mississauga, Milton, Guelph, Cambridge, Kitchener, Woodstock and other communities along its route.

Registration fees are \$25 per rider and \$10 per passenger with participants encouraged to collect donation pledges from sponsors. Registration forms are available from all Royal Bank branches.

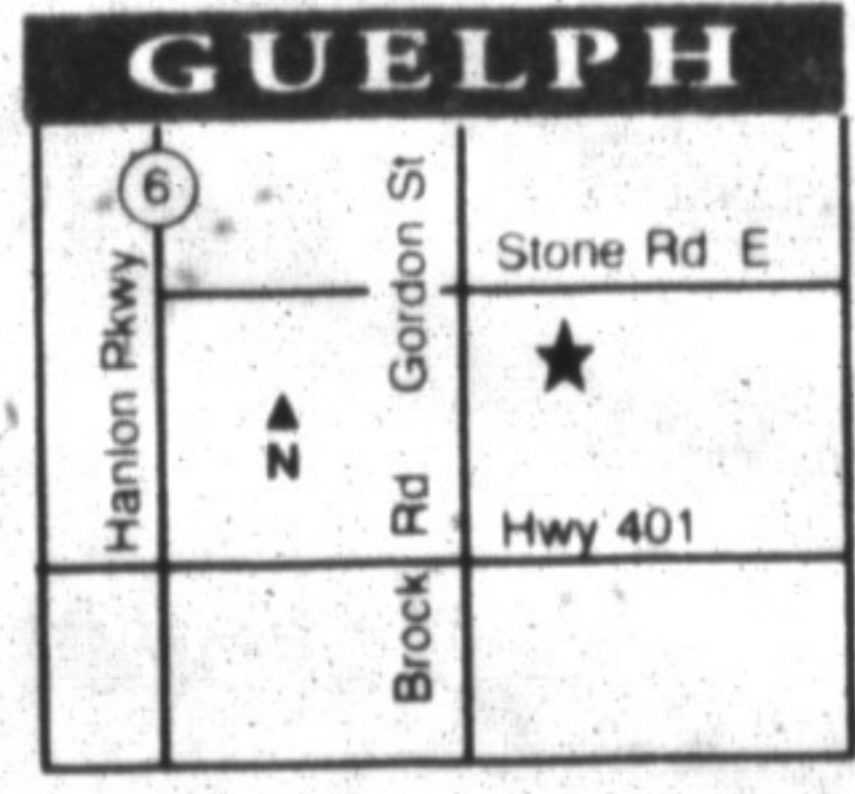
