The Niagara Escarpment Planning and Development Act, R.S.O. 1990

The Niagara Escarpment Commission has initiated an amendment to the Niagara Escarpment Plan.

Amendment No. 113 proposes:

To amend Part 1 and Part 2 and Appendix 2 of the Niagara Escarpment Plan to include policies and definitions to provide for a second dwelling on a lot in the Escarpment Protection Area or Escarpment Rural Area and in special circumstances in the Escarpment Natural Area where the existing dwelling has been designated under the Ontario Heritage Act, or is of Provincial or National significance.
