Thousands expected at Steam-Era this weekend

About 15,000 people are expected to gather for a fun-filled weekend at the Milton Fair Grounds.
The four-day 36th annual Steam-Era Reunion opens today with puffing steam engines, chugging gas tractors and humming gasoline engines.
The putt-putting of old cars and trucks will also be heard among thousands of miscellaneous displays at the celebration of Ontario's rich agricultural heritage.
The show that has put Milton on the map will feature Rumely tractors this year. About 45 of them will be on display, according to the Ontario Steam and Antique Preservers Association, the event's organizer.
The largest event of its kind in the province, Steam-Era will also feature parades at 4 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

Other activities will be threshing competitions (Saturday and Monday afternoons) and antique tractor pulls (Saturday and Monday mornings).
At the grandstand, log sawing, bag tying and sheaf tying will take place on a regular basis throughout the weekend.
A country and western talent contest will be held Saturday evening and a variety program will provide the entertainment Sunday night.
Today's action wraps up at dusk. The show will continue Saturday and Monday from 8 a.m. to dusk and Sunday from 11 a.m. to dusk.
