# Catch the spirit on Saturday at novel Rockwood festival

The Spirit Valley Experience has announced several more acts for their Saturday festival of the arts in Rockwood.

Canadian soul singer Salome Bey, originally from Newark, New Jersey has performed in virtually every type of musical venue from children's theatre to the Montreux Jazz Festival and Broadway shows. She and her band "The Relatives" will perform at the festival.

Spirit Valley will also have the North American premiere of Diaspora Cia Bahiana, a Brazilian dance troupe. The dance form originated among Angolan slaves who disguised their martial arts skills as dance in order to practice openly.

The Skazka Ensemble of the Imperial Balalaika Orchestra will have its first Canadian appearance at

the festival. The balalaika is unique to Russian folk music, and the orchestra was started in 1888.

Loretto Reid and Brian Tahenny emigrated to Canada in 1988 from Sligo, Ireland and brought with them their distinctive musical style. With two recent recordings and a wealth of broadcast and film credits they have a tight live performance schedule, including tours of Germany and northwestern France.

The Spirit Valley Experience is slated rain or shine for the Rockwood Conservation Area on Saturday, Sept. 7. Tickets are \$30 in advance and \$35 at the gate.
