


sound on the United Nations International Day of Peace, Tuesday, September 17th.

## Small grants end

Small annual grants to social service agencies will be phased out as part of Halton Region's overall subsidy restructuring.


In the works for several years, the phasing out of social service grants will allow Halton to finance new short-term programs which are not covered by provincial funding.

Pending council approval the restructured funding will begin during the 1998 budget cycle, when it is expected the new Healthy Community

Program is focused on prevention of problems.

**Burlington Mayor Walter** Mulkewich said the region should be prepared to move into a great variety of new organizational structures and "move away from 1980s thinking."

A review of grant funding in 1995 resulted in four agencies being cut off from regional grants, a 20 per cent decrease in grants to two agencies, a phase-out of small grants to seven large agencies over three years and joint funding and amalgamation proposals from 13 agencies. Program will be phased in. The budget was reduced 20 The Healthy Community per cent to \$527,000 for 1996.
