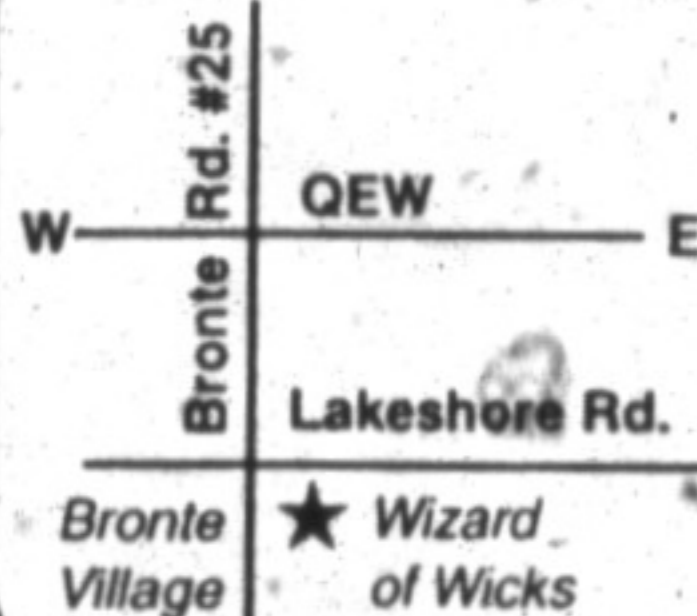

## Sheppard murder jury on hold

There's no telling when a jury will begin to hear evidence in a first-degree-murder trial.

The trial, which has been repeatedly pushed back, remains on hold while wrangles continue over legal issues.

Jurors, who were required to call the courthouse Tuesday afternoon to see if their services would be needed Wednesday, were told not to come back for a week.

The trial, which is expected to last four weeks, was

scheduled to start September 3, but legal arguments and other issues have caused numerous postponements.

The seven-woman, five-man jury chosen in early September has now been told to report to the courthouse Tuesday at 2 p.m.

Keith Madeley, 22, stands trial in the shooting death of Fred Sheppard, 77, of Steeles Avenue. The life-long Miltonian was found slain in the outhouse behind his Niagara Escarpment home.

## Two seniors groups are joining forces

Two major seniors groups have joined forces.

The Canadian Grey Panthers and the United Senior Citizens of Ontario (USCO) have forged a partnership.

The Grey Panthers, founded three years ago by gerontologist Joe Moniz, number some 30,000 members nationally. USCO, now in its 40th year, includes seniors groups across Ontario and numbers close to 300,000. USCO is headed by Al Smith, a 22-year veteran of Orillia city council.

"Call it co-operation, instead of competition," said

Mr. Moniz. "The USCO has an excellent track record in senior education and advocacy, with well defined initiatives and we share many of the same goals."

"The Panthers/USCO partnership is a major step forward for all seniors," Mr. Moniz said. "Instead of wasting precious resources on competition or on duplication, we'll collectively tackle the real issues."

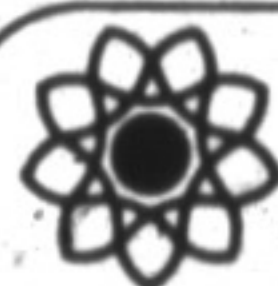
