There's no telling when a jury will begin to hear evidence in a first-degree-murder trial.

The trial, which has been repeatedly pushed back, ments. remains on hold while wrangles continue over legal issues.

Jurors, who were required to call the courthouse Tuesday afternoon to see if their services would be needed Wednesday, were told not to come back for a

The trial, which is expected to last four weeks, was

scheduled to start September 3, but legal arguments and other issues have caused numerous postpone-

The seven-woman, five-man jury chosen in early September has now been told to report to the courthouse Tuesday at 2 p.m.

Keith Madeley, 22, stands trial in the shooting death of Fred Sheppard, 77, of Steeles Avenue. The lifelong Miltonian was found slain in the outhouse behind his Niagara Escarpment home.


