GTA mayors unveil new website

Mayors of Greater Toronto Area (GTA) municipalities met in Milton last week and were treated to a cyber-ribbon cutting for the new GTA website and a look at the Ontario Agricultural Museum.

In addition the 28 mayors who attended the meeting talked about impending changes to the Municipal Act and listened to a presentation from the president of the Canadian Bankers Association.

The GTA website, aimed at the national and international business community, incorporated a short video clip extolling the virtues of the GTA.

According to Tom Vassos, manager of internet strategy at IBM, Canada, there are 20 external links to the GTA site, including those of GTA municipalities and businesses. He said phase two of the internet strategy will be set up the site to act as an umbrella for all companies in the GTA with websites.
