

# Two thirsty break-in suspects bagged with beer

Two youths were arrested in connection with break-ins at the Esso gas bar and Ice House Restaurant at the main intersection of Campbellville.

A citizen alerted Halton Regional Police that suspicious people were hanging out in the area at 2 a.m. Saturday.

Police responded and discovered that the two break-ins had occurred and the culprits were about to rob the nearby Livery.

Cases of beer were recovered.

The thief smashed the front door to gain entry, police said. No one was home.

The four-door black jeep worth \$30,000 was taken from a Valleyview Crescent driveway sometime after midnight October 15.

The two-door red Porsche was stolen from a Lower Base Line driveway overnight October 13.

The bus shelter at Ontario Street and Steeles Avenue was kicked out October 12 shortly before 3 p.m. Police arrived and charged a male youth.

## Pumpkin pick-up is on Monday

Students from Milton District High School (MDHS) will be joined by those from Bishop Reding for their annual pumpkin collection.

MDHS students began collecting the pumpkins after Halloween in 1991, transferring them to a local farm for feed and compost. Pumpkins cannot have any spray paint or decorative objects on them.

The collection is slated for Monday, Nov. 4 between 8:45 a.m. and noon.

The Town of Milton will support the project by providing two trucks and drivers to assist in the pick-up. The entire urban area within the Steeles Avenue, Thompson Road, Derry Road and Bronte Street quadrant will be canvassed.



## Property tax talks

The Tax Equity Alliance is encouraging people to attend a two day conference called Property Tax Reform - Options for Ontario, on Nov. 1-2. The conference is sponsored by the City of Toronto and is open to municipal councillors, MPPs, ratepayer groups, school trustees, business associations, appraisers, developers and legal and accounting professionals.

The conference is slated for the Sheraton Centre Hotel at 123 Queen Street West in Toronto.

A key conference feature is speakers from jurisdictions where alternative property tax systems are in place, especially those systems which do not rely on updated market values to define equity in taxation. An international panel will discuss acquisition price assessment (California), area based assessment (Israel), council tax and non-domestic rates assessment (Britain) and actual value assessment (British Columbia).

As part of each session speakers will invite questions from the floor in order for individual concerns to be addressed. The first day of the conference will focus on international perspectives with the second day devoted to Ontario's concerns.
